

Directions to Citizens Television 2666 State Street, Hamden in ED MOR PARK

Participation Guidelines for “[21st Century Conversations](#)” Community Program Specials

1. Directions from Hartford Traveling South: Coming from Hartford you will take exit #10 off 91 going south. Take Exit #1 off the ramp; at the traffic light take a right to State Street, Hamden. This means staying to your right. Follow State Street for about one mile until you see ED-MOR PARK on your right. It is a hidden driveway; please pay attention. Go up the driveway; CTV is in the middle of the long building in front of you.

2. Directions from downtown New Haven Via State Street: Come up State pass the DMV; travel for another half to two-thirds of a mile. The ED-MOR Park will be on your left. The driveway is inset, so look out for it. Go up the driveway, CTV is in the middle of the long building in Suite #4. **The phone number at CTV is (203) 562-2288. If you are lost, call Citizens Television and get directions. Do NOT drive around and arrive late!** If you register to participate and cannot come, please call (203) 407-0250.

Directions from 95 Going North: At Long Wharf, stay into the left lane that will put you onto 91 going north. Get off at exit 10; take exit #1 off exit 10; at the light take a right; follow the directions in #1 above.

4. From the Merritt Parkway going north: Take exit 60; at the ramp take a left; go through the center of Hamden; stay in the right lane. Immediately after passing the plaza on your right, turn right onto Skiff Street. Follow Skiff to the very end; you will arrive at State Street. Take a right onto State. Go about one-third mile; ED-MOR Park will be a hidden driveway on your right. **See #1 above for more details.** .

Be sure that the directions given by MapQuest are for Citizens Television at 2666 State Street in Hamden and **NOT for State Street, New Haven.** If you have problems, call (203) 562-2288 for directions.

If you are not familiar with the area, please allow yourself extra travel time.
